

Electrical certificate of compliance - emergency after-hours repairs

This certificate of compliance is only to be used by electrical workers or contractors who have completed emergency after-hours repairs at a property and need to provide a certificate of compliance to the network provider before they reconnect the property to the grid.

Electrical workers or contractors who use this form will need to resubmit the information via the online electrical safety certificate of compliance available at:
